

**24th INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM
ON CHROMATOGRAPHY**
(15 – 20 SEPTEMBER, 2002, LEIPZIG)

This Symposium is the 24th in a series of International meetings that began in London, UK in 1956 and is held every two years in Europe. The symposium has been the leading forum for presentations and discussions on developments in all areas of chromatographic and related separation techniques. The symposium series is run by The Chromatographic Society (UK), Association Française des Sciences Séparatives (France) and Gesellschaft Deutscher Chemiker, Fachgruppe Analytische Chemie, Arbeitskreis Chromatographie (Germany). The ISC '02 will be organized by the Arbeitskreis Chromatographie of Gesellschaft Deutscher Chemiker in cooperation with the University of Leipzig and other national associations. The conference will take place in the auditoria of the university situated in the city of Leipzig.

Scientific Program

The scientific program will feature invited keynote speakers, selected submitted lectures and poster presentations. The state of the art, recent achievements and future trends will be covered. We invite contributions from all branches of chromatography and related separation techniques including sample preparation and coupled techniques (hyphenated methods). Parallel sessions dealing with the application of separation techniques in different scientific disciplines like medicine, biochemistry, food, environmental, toxicology etc. will be provided. Papers for both lectures and posters will appear in a special issue of an chromatographic journal. A Seminar "Young scientists present their results" will be organized. As in the past, an integral part of the meeting will be an exhibition of the most recent developments in instrumentation, accessories, services and literature by the leading manufactures and distributors.
